- I understand that my child/ward has received approval from me to participate in the SunPower-sponsored Solar Energy Academy. This enrichment opportunity is under the direct supervision of at least one teacher and all precautions are taken to ensure each student's welfare.
- I understand that my student must arrive to the Solar Energy Academy on time. The field trips incorporated into the Solar Energy Academy experience are an important part of the curricula. Although teachers will, of course, make every effort to assist students who are absent, they cannot deliver individual lectures or demonstrations, instruction or labs to accommodate absenteeism. If the student misses a day of camp, s/he will not be eligible for the \$150 stipend.
- I understand that all students going to the Solar Energy & SunPower field trips will be responsible in conduct to the teacher, bus driver, chaperones and, if applicable, adult sponsors, at all times. I understand that ALL CHAPERONES WILL BE 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.
- I understand that students are required to go and return from the SunPower field trips on the transportation provided.
- I understand that all field trips will begin and end at Las Positas College.
- I hereby acknowledge that I have been advised the activities in this Solar Energy Academy, which includes two days of field trips which may include visits to SunPower facilities and other industry sites as determined by the Academy staff, and they are considered to be of "high risk" to participants.
- The Solar Energy Academy does not provide students with field trip or camp accident insurance. Parents who do not have medical insurance that covers their children are strongly advised to consider alternative student accident insurance that is available. The Solar Energy Academy does not sell private vendor insurance.
- It is understood and agreed that this Solar Energy Academy, and visits to SunPower and other industry sites shall constitute an event for the purposes of California Education Code Section 35330 waiver provided below.

***WAIVER OF CLAIM**

I _____, as the parent/guardian of _____, agrees to release, indemnify and hold harmless Bay Area LEED's Solar Energy Academy staff including the Tri-Valley Solar Energy Academy and SunPower Corporation from and against all claims, damages, losses, expenses and liabilities, including reasonable attorney's fees and expenses in case it shall be necessary to file an action, arising out of your child's participation in the Tri-Valley Solar Energy Academy. I understand that the Solar Energy Academy is held on a college campus and there are field trips to businesses that have rules that apply fully to all Academy participants. My child and I are fully responsible for reading, understanding and adhering to the dress code, code of conduct and safety rules required on field trip permission forms. Failure to comply may prevent my child from participation in certain scheduled activities and/or result in removal from the camp. This includes release, indemnification and hold harmless for (1) bodily injury, illness or death, or for property damage, including loss of use caused in whole or in part by Bay Area LEEDS, SunPower and its Solar Energy Academy agents, contractors, consultants and volunteers' negligent acts or omissions during all aspects of the Solar Energy Academy.

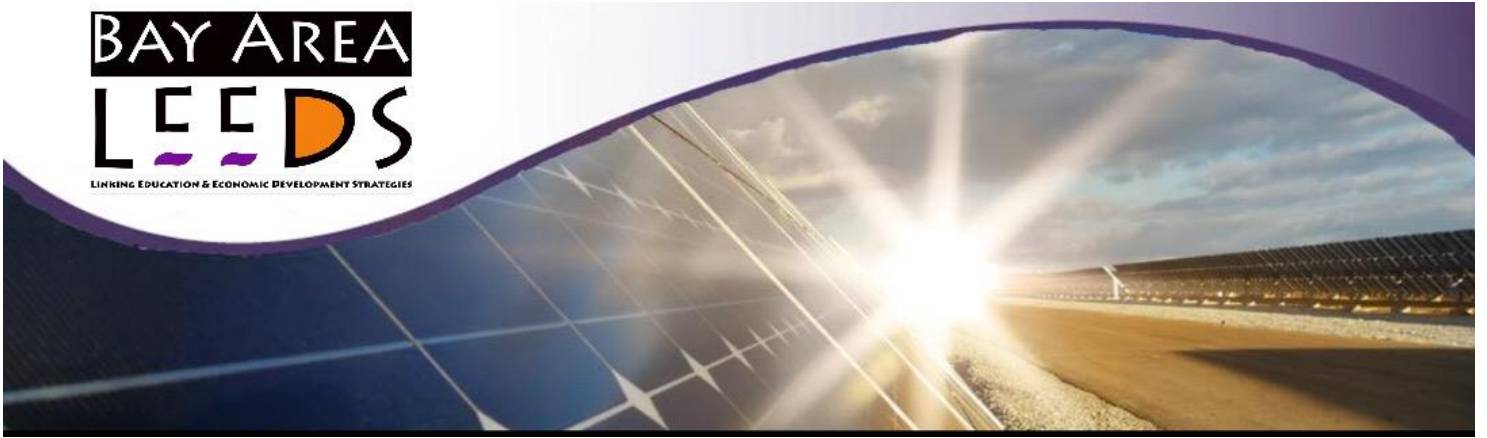
