Student Responsibilities

Diablo Valley College Engineering Summer Camp June 8-12, 2020

The Diablo Valley College Engineering Camp is meant to be fun and educational. To ensure that you learn as much as possible, there are two focuses of achievement that will be your daily goal:

1. Academic assignments
2. Work Based Learning skills development and application

Most of the academic assignments are written reflections on the content of the camp activities and/or articles to read on such things as camp field studies to local business sites related to the Engineering, Construction and Manufacturing Industries. You will record your reflections in the provided journal. Completion of these assignments will lead to the unit of college credit from DVC and reflect your academic achievement. Your teachers will observe and guide you at camp as you practice the daily skills assigned. Teachers will make note of the skills where you demonstrate competency or improvement.

1. Presentations: Take notes and write a reflection paragraph on each of the speakers/demonstrators. Your notes should include: at least three important concepts or facts, at least three interesting concepts or details, summarize the presentation, and provide your personal reaction to the content.
2. Field studies (2-3 of the camp week): In one page, reflect on each visit to include: the location and type of business visited, what was most interested about what was presented and why, what types of careers did you witness or hear discussed which were of interest to you and why, would you like to work at that business – why or why not.
3. Project Write-ups: You will be engaged in a number of team lab assignments and projects that reflect skills required in Engineering Pathways. During each project/assignment take note of the equipment, methods, and procedures utilized in completing the assigned work. After each project or assignment, you should write a report in your journal that includes the following:
 - Purpose of the assignment/project/competition.
 - Product: What was the end product and how was it used, how did the team accomplish the goal?
 - Careers: What are some possible careers that would require the same or similar skills you and your team used in completing the assignment?
 - Identify three items you learned and/or practiced in completing the assigned project/work.
4. Safety and Cleanliness: Each day at camp you will be expected to practice appropriate industry safety and cleanliness procedures, including adhering to the professional dress code as stated in the camp requirements, following directions, being considerate of other class members and cleaning up your work station daily.
5. Just as in school and work, your attendance is important. You will be assigned to work with a team of other students. Daily participation of each team member is expected, as well as working cooperatively and collaboratively to accomplish common goals. ***In order to earn the 1 unit of college credit, students must attend and participate all five days of the camp. If you are not going to be able to attend camp or need to leave early, please notify the teacher in charge of your team as soon as possible.***
