HELP! Contra Costa County Science & Engineering Fair is scheduled for Friday, March 10 from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and we need your help! The Fair will be held in-person at the Los Medanos College Gymnasium, in Pittsburg.

In existence since 2005, the Contra Costa Science Fair expects to have more than 120 student competitors who will need your expertise to evaluate project boards and conduct interviews.

The fair will require a full 8 hours of judges' time to ensure every child gets interviewed about their project. Won't you volunteer to be a judge on March 10?

Judges choose among the six competition categories:

- behavioral/social sciences including gerontology;
- biological including biochemistry, microbiology, zoology, botany, medicine, and health;
- engineering;
- environmental sciences;
- math/computer sciences; and
- physical science including chemistry, earth and space, physics.

There are two student competition levels: JUNIOR: Grades 7 and 8; and SENIOR: Grades 9 through 12. You may choose the competition level most suited to your preferences.

Our goal is to engage more than 140 judges to be on hand to give every child the opportunity to share their science and engineering projects with multiple judges during the competition. The winners of the Contra Costa regional fair are then eligible for further competition at the California State Science Fair, the National Middle School Science Fair, and the Regeneron-affiliated International Science & Engineering Fair. Without your involvement further competitions would not be available to our student competitors.

It's easy to register to be a judge, and you will have same-day training to prepare you for the experience (see Judging Day agenda below). Won't you join other volunteers, experienced and new, at our 2023 fair by completing the registration link now?
